February 18 Ancient Rome Arrive in Rome and enjoy a panoramic tour of Ancient Rome before transferring to the port of Civitavecchia to board the beautiful Norwegian Jade.

February 21 Alanya, Turkey The **Aspendos** amphitheatre, known for its outstanding acoustics, is extremely well preserved and still in use today for special events. Nearby is **Perge**, a Hellenistic city where Paul preached (Acts 14: 25). The ruins of a large stadium, baths, and a tomb give ample evidence of its former greatness. Paul and Barnabas visited here on their first journey.

February 22 Cyprus The first visit on Paul's first journey was the island of Cyprus. Barnabas and John Mark accompanied Paul on this part of the journey and the three preached the word of God on the island in the "synagogues of the Jews" (Acts 13:4-5). Today you will arrive in **Limassol, Cyprus** a modern port. From here you will continue on to ancient **Paphos** where Paul and Barnabas brought the gospel to the Roman proconsul Sergius Paulus and were resisted by the sorcerer known as Bar-Jesus (Acts 13:6-12).

February 23 Haifa Your cruise ship docks in the port of **Haifa**. Travel inland to the **Sea of Galilee**. Much of the Gospel is centered around the Sea. You'll stand on the **Mount of the Beatitudes** where Jesus gave his most famous sermon (Luke 6:12-49). At **Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10-17). Visit the **Chapel of the Primacy**

where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). Travel to the shore town of **Capernaum** where Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, John (Matt 4:13) and later Matthew. Stop by the **River Jordan** where those who wish to be baptized may do so.

February 24 Ashdod Dock in the port of **Ashdod**. Travel to **Jerusalem** and visit the **Upper Room**, the traditional site of the Last Supper. Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas**, where Jesus was tried before the Sanhedrin. Stand upon the **Mount of Olives** and view the city as Jesus did. Dr. Luker also serves as Faculty Associate in the Department of Religious Studies at the University of South Carolina and has been Professor of Bible at the Jerusalem Center for Biblical Studies since 1997. He is a member of the Society of Biblical Literature, the American Schools of Oriental Research, the Biblical Archaeology Society, and the National Association of Professors of Hebrew.

Similarly without limiting the foregoing, passenger agrees to hold EOT/NTS harmless for any defect in any vehicle, plane, boat, bus, car, van or other vehicle, act of war or insurrection, terrorist activity, revolt or other civil uprising, military action, strikes or labor unrest or any Act of God or for any other act of any third party. Florida law will be applicable to any dispute which arises out of or concerns this brochure or your tour.
