


Pilgrimage to the Holy Land

Feb. 14 – Departure

Your journey begins when you depart the USA on your overnight international flight.

Feb. 15 – Arrival

Welcome to the Holy Land! On arrival, you will be met by our representative at the airport and transferred to your Tel Aviv area hotel for dinner and a good night's rest.

Feb. 16 – From Sea to Sea

Today you'll make your way from the shores of the Mediterranean to the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Start your day at **Caesarea Maritima**, the coastal city built by Herod the Great. Explore the extensive ruins including the massive theater and aqueduct. Stand atop **Mount Carmel** where Elijah called down fire from heaven to defeat the prophets of ba'al. Visit **Tel Megiddo**, a remarkable site where the remains of 20 cities lie superimposed over one another. From there you can look out over the Valley of Armageddon. Drive through Cana, where Jesus performed the miracle of the wedding feast. Visit **Nazareth**, Jesus' boyhood home, and the **Mount of Precipice**, where Jesus was rejected by those in the synagogue. Continue to Tiberias in the Galilee for dinner & overnight.

Feb. 17 – Northern Israel & Galilee

Journey north to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ". Enjoy a traditional **St. Peter's Fish** lunch (included). Explore **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus ministry in the Galilee. Stand on the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount and reflect on what it means to be blessed. Finish the day at the **River Jordan**, where you can remember or renew your baptism.

Feb. 18 – Galilee to Jerusalem

This morning sail across the **Sea of Galilee** as you share in a time of worship on the water. Visit **Gideon's Spring** at Ein Harod, where Gideon chose his army of 300. Travel through the **Jordan River Valley**, the route often taken by Jesus and other Galileans as they traveled to and from Jerusalem. Pass through the Judean Wilderness paralleling the ancient Roman road to view the **Valley of the Shadow**. From here, you can see St. George's Monastery across the gorge. Check into your Jerusalem hotel for dinner & overnight.

Feb. 19 – Jerusalem

Start your morning on the **Mount of Olives** where you can take in a remarkable view of the **Old City**. It was from this mount that Jesus ascended into heaven 40 days after the Resurrection. Walk down the **Palm Sunday Path** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus prayed among the olive trees the night he was betrayed with a kiss. Stand on the steps of the **Pool of Siloam**, where Jesus healed the blind man. See the bronze **Knesset Menorah** which includes a series of reliefs that depict the struggle of the Jewish people. Pray alongside the Jewish faithful at the **Western Wall**.

Feb. 20 – Jerusalem

In modern Jerusalem visit **Yad Vashem**, Israel's Holocaust Memorial, with its poignant exhibits honoring the millions of lives lost during the Holocaust. At the **Temple Institute**, view the replicas of the instruments used for worship and sacrifice in the Jewish Temple. Continue to the **Israel Museum** where you can view an impressive **Model of 1st century Jerusalem**. Also on the museum grounds is the **Shrine of the Book** where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display.

Feb. 21 – Masada & the Dead Sea

Travel south to **Masada**, the spectacular mountaintop fortress of Herod the Great, which is famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Take the cable car to the top and peer down at the Roman camps and siege ramp below. This afternoon take a dip in the salt and mineral laden waters of the **Dead Sea**, which is the lowest point on the surface of the earth!

Feb. 22 – Jerusalem

Walk through the **Old City** and enjoy the preserved, ancient culture found in the narrow streets as well as the modernized **Cardo** in the Jewish Quarter. View the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Walk a portion of the **Via Dolorosa** (Way of Suffering). Take time to reflect on the agony of the cross at **Gordon's Calvary** and the miraculous reality of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**. This evening prepare for the journey home and transfer to the airport for your late night flight.

Feb. 23 – Return Home

Return home with a transformed faith and memories to last a lifetime!

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is per person based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While NTS will try to match roommates, NTS cannot guarantee a roommate will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 30 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$600 during the basic tour.

PAYMENT:

All prices reflect a 4% discount for full payment via check. A full deposit of \$300 per person is required. An additional deposit of \$1500 and full Travel protection premium is due 11/01/17. Travel Protection Premiums must be paid in addition to initial or second deposit prior to the final payment for coverage to be in effect. Final payment for trip is due 12/01/17. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100 will be assessed.

REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED after November 1, 2017:

We welcome registrations after 11/01/17. Registrations received between 11/02/17 - 11/16/17 will incur a \$100 per person fee. Registrations received between 11/17/17 - 12/01/17 will incur a \$200 per person fee. Registrations received between 12/02/17 - 12/16/17 will incur a \$400 per person fee. Registrations received on 12/17/17 or later will incur an additional fee based on air availability. Additional fees will be advised upon registration.

CANCELLATION FEES:

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges: 104-60 days = \$400; 59-45 days = \$600; 44-31 days = 40% of total cost; 30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. FIT TO TRAVEL STATEMENT:

Passengers registering for the tour accept the responsibility for being in good health and able to walk and travel on the tour. Because many of the sites are not accessible to the physically challenged, those needing oxygen, wheelchairs, or other ambulatory assistance will find the tour extremely limiting to their experiences. PASSPORT INFORMATION, CONFIRMATION OF ITINERARY & CHECK IN PROCESS:

Passport information must be submitted to our office no later than 11/01/17. Failure to provide your passport information to our office by this date may result in change fees or denial of travel. Approximately 105 days prior to your trip you will be contacted to re-confirm your itinerary, travel arrangements and registration information during the preliminary check in process for your trip. Discrepancies in information or failure to check in for your tour may result in change fees, delays in receiving travel documents for your trip, or denial of travel.

PRICE INCREASES:

All prices quoted in this brochure are subject to change prior to payment in full due to currency fluctuations, fuel surcharge increases, government taxes and fees increases or unforeseen circumstances. In addition, you may be subject to a price increase after payment in full has been received due to potential government imposed taxes and fees.

AIRLINE ROUTES and TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, NTS does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once "printed", airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class on IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together on entire itinerary.
