Journey to Israel 2019

Sunday, November 24 – TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Today we depart from the USA for Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

Monday, November 25 – ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

We arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and are transferred to our hotel in Tiberias for check-in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

Tuesday, November 26 – CAESAREA PHILIPPI, TEL DAN, DOLMENS, MT. BENTAL, VALLEY OF TEARS, PEACE OVERLOOK

Today experience Israel north of Galilee. Journey to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter proclaimed that Jesus was the Messiah. Continue to **Tel Dan**, one of ancient Israel's boundary markers - "From Dan to Beersheba. Visit the **Graveyard of the Giants** and see the hundreds of dolmens that have been found in the Golan Heights. Used for burial in the basalt areas where grave digging is difficult, dolmens were used for burial during both the Early Bronze I and Intermediate Bronze periods. From **Mount Bental**, look out over the Damascus Road and the **Valley of Tears** where a severely outnumbered Israel defense force stopped the Syrian invasion of the Golan Heights in the Yom Kippur War of 1973. Drive up to **Peace Overlook** to get a marvelous view of the entire Sea of Galilee.

Wednesday, November 27 – MAGDALA, CAPERNAUM, TABGHA, BOAT RIDE, FISH LUNCH, CHORAZIM, MOUNT OF BEATITUDES, JORDAN RIVER

After enjoying an Israeli buffet breakfast, we will spend most of our day around the Sea of Galilee. We start the day with a drive along the shores of the lake, visiting the area of **Magdala**, home of Mary Magdalene. Next, we travel to **Capernaum**, and stand in the ruins of the synagogue built atop the remains of the one in which our Lord Jesus taught. Further down the shoreline is **Tabgha**, the site of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9). We will have great fellowship on a beautiful boat ride across the Sea of Galilee after which we can enjoy a **fish lunch** (included) at a restaurant located on the shores of the lake. We will walk the streets of **Chorazim**, listed as a "city of woe" by Jesus (Matt. 11). Visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7) before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, November 28 – NAZARETH VILLAGE, MEGIDDO, MOUNT CARMEL, CAESAREA MARITIMA

After our delicious buffet breakfast and hotel checkout, we journey west to **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of Jesus (Luke 2), where we will step back in time at **Nazareth Village**, a living history of the life of Jesus of Nazareth. Continuing west, we will arrive at **Tel Megiddo** overlooking the Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16). We'll journey to the top of **Mount Carmel**, where Elijah prayed down the fire from Heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). Arriving at the Mediterranean Sea, we will stop at **Caesarea Maritima** on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 - 26). After a full day of sightseeing, we will arrive in the capital city of Jerusalem, where we can check in to our hotel, enjoy dinner and a special **Thanksgiving celebration**.

Friday, November 29 – MODEL CITY - SHRINE OF THE BOOK, MOUNT OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

We begin our day by gaining some insights into the Jerusalem of Jesus' day with a look at the **First Century Model** of the City of Jerusalem. Also in this location is the **Shrine of the Book Museum** displaying the book of Isaiah from the Dead Sea Scrolls. Next, we'll stand atop the **Mount of Olives** (Luke 19 & II Sam. 15), pointing out the Site of the Ascension (Acts 1), the Temple Platform and other Biblical events from this vantage point. Together we'll walk down **Palm Sunday Road** and take time to pray among the ancient olive trees in the **Garden of Gethsemane** (John 18).

Saturday, November 30

MASADA, DEAD SEA, QUMRAN, VALLEY OF THE SHADOW

Enjoy a visit to intriguing **Masada**, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod the Great that later became the final tragic stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress and look down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Go to the shores of the **Dead Sea** to experience the salt and mineral laden waters at the lowest point on earth! Visit **Qumran**, the location

of caves out of which the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered after being hidden for over 19 centuries in its wilderness caves. As we make our way to Jerusalem, we will stop at the **Valley of the Shadow**, and overlook point in the quiet and desolate **Judean Wilderness**. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, December 1 – CAIAPHAS' HOUSE, RABBI'S TUNNEL, WESTERN WALL, SOUTHERN STEPS

Begin our day by visiting the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas** (John 18) and walk through some of the ancient rooms. We'll follow the Herodian support wall and walk on First Century pavement in the **Rabbi's Tunnel**. A part of this visit will include time at the **Western Wall**, where we can touch a part of history, pray and insert written prayers into the crevices of this historic retaining wall of **Herod's Temple**. Around the corner from the Western Wall is the **Southern Steps**, access point to the Temple of our Lord's time. We can sit on these steps and enjoy a time of Biblical reflection on events that took place in this area. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Monday, December 2 – OLD CITY, SISTER'S OF ZION CHURCH, CARDO, POOL OF BETHESDA, GARDEN TOMB - GORDON'S CALVARY

This final morning of our journey will bring us into the **Old City** to the **Cardo**. This ancient marketplace has ruins that date back to the Judean monarchy among modern shops. Part of the Old City walk is the Via Dolorosa, including the **Sister's of Zion Church**, location of the **Antonia Fortress** and possible location of the trial of our Lord prior to the crucifixion. The games of the Roman soldiers are still etched in its stone floor. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle and sing in the church of St. Anne. Finally, reflect on the agony of Christ's crucifixion at **Gordon's Calvary** (Luke 23) and the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**! After our final dinner in Israel, prepare for departure to the USA.

Tuesday, December 3 – ARRIVE IN USA

Today we arrive in the USA, filled with a lifetime of memories to cherish.



ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is per person based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While NTS will try to match roommates, NTS cannot guarantee a roommate will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 30 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$800 during the basic week, FSR NA - If the passenger is a forced single, they must pay the single supp if they want to guarantee that they will have a single room on the tour. If not, we will place them in a single, but with no obligation that they will have the single throughout the tour. If there needs to be a roommate adjustment within the group of the same gender, the forced single will be receiving a roommate to accommodate the adjustment. Also, they cannot at that time pay for a single and secure it because there might not be a single room available in the hotel. The only way to guarantee a single room is to pay for it before the tour departs.

PAYMENT:

All prices reflect a 4% discount for full payment via check. A full deposit of \$300 per person is required. An additional deposit of \$1500 and full Travel protection premium is due 08/11/19. Travel Protection Premiums must be paid in addition to initial or second deposit prior to the final payment for coverage to be in effect. Final payment for trip is due 09/10/19. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100 will be assessed.

REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED after August 11, 2019:

We welcome registrations after 08/11/19. Registrations received between 08/12/19 - 08/26/19 will incur a \$100 per person fee. Registrations received between 08/27/19 - 09/10/19 will incur a \$200 per person fee. Registrations received between 09/11/19 - 09/25/19 will incur a \$400 per person fee. Registrations received on 09/26/19 or later will incur an additional fee based on air availability. Additional fees will be advised upon registration.

CANCELLATION FEES:

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is coverable.
