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### September 17 & 18 – USA to Athens

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed at the Athens airport by our representative and transferred to your hotel to enjoy dinner before retiring for the night.

### September 19 – Panoramic Bus Athens Tour

Discover the rich architectural splendor of the ancient city of Athens as you explore the world-renowned Acropolis, the Propylaea, the Parthenon, and the Erechtheum. Stand on Mars Hill as the Apostle Paul did when he proclaimed, “I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.” Also, view the House of Parliament, the Presidential Palace, and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Return to your Athens hotel for dinner and your overnight rest. (Some of these sites may be included on your return today in Athens.)

### September 20 – Board Miray Cruise Ship/ Mykonos

Check into your outside cabin and set sail to Mykonos. Mykonos, chosen as the most beautiful island in the world by one of the world’s leading travel magazines “Conde Nast Traveler”, is the most popular of the Greek Islands with its colorful bougainvillea overhanging from its snow-white balconies, houses decorated with geraniums and the row of windmills on the docks. Nestled in the heart of Greece’s Cyclades archipelago, Mykonos pulses with irrepressible energy. With its powder white houses and sparkling blue waters, the Island of the Winds is as colorful as the people who call the island home. You can walk narrow marble pathways laced with purple bougainvillea blooms or cycle on two wheels past off-the-path Ano Mera village. Explore Greece’s maritime history at Armenistis Lighthouse and check out the Folklore Museum’s Mykonian ship models.

### September 21 – Santorini

Next stop, dock in Santorini, one of the most beautiful of the Greek islands, where picturesque, whitewashed villages topped with brilliant blue domes stand in stark contrast to the sheer drop cliffs overlooking the Aegean Sea. The island perches on the edges of a volcano whose eruption 3,500 years ago is thought to have led to the collapse of the Minoan civilization. Explore the island on your own or join one of the optional excursions available for purchase on board.

### September 22 – Kusadasi, Patmos

Ephesus is one of the Seven Churches of Revelation and was once a bustling port town with wide, colonnade-bordered

streets and a population of 250,000. Spectacular excavations have revealed much of the glory of ancient Ephesus, including the huge agora and library, but much has been lost. The ancient world once declared the Temple of Artemis one of the Seven Wonders of the World, but today, only a single column remains to mark its site. View the terrace houses, also known as “the houses of the rich,” which give a true impression of the ancient lifestyle. Explore Patmos, where the Apostle John was exiled and later received the Revelation of Jesus Christ as he recorded the final book of our New Testament. *(Today’s shore excursions are included)*

### September 23 – Disembark/ Athens & Corinth Touring/ Overnight in Athens

Today, tour the city of Corinth, where the Apostle Paul met fellow tentmakers Aquila and Priscilla and received a vision from the Lord saying, “I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city”. As Paul spoke, Crispus (chief ruler of the synagogue) and many others believed and were baptized, establishing the church at Corinth to whom Paul later wrote his two epistles. Discover the archaeological museum, marketplace, and temples. As you walk among the ruins, stand on the Bema, where the Apostle Paul stood before Gallio to face charges brought against him by the Jews. Return to Athens for dinner and your overnight stay.

### September 24 – Early Morning Flight to the USA or Continue with Extension

### September 24 – Arrive in Rome

Your assistant will greet you at the airport and escort you to the hotel in Rome. Check into your accommodations. The rest of the day is at leisure. Stay overnight in Rome. Lunch and dinner are not included.

### September 25 – Rome

After breakfast at the hotel, a local guide will escort you to Ancient Rome. You can tour two of the most important sites, the Colosseum and the Roman Forum. Afterward, transfer back to your hotel. You will have free time after lunch (lunch is not included). In the afternoon, take a walking tour, which includes Baroque Rome, the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain, and Navona Square. Head back to your hotel after the tour. Lunch and dinner are not included. Overnight in Rome.

### September 26 – Rome, Pompeii, Amalfi Coast & Sorrento

After breakfast at your hotel, you will check out. You will take a private mini-bus to the south of Italy. Here, you will stop in Pompeii and walk through the ancient ruins with your guide. After visiting Pompeii, your tour will continue to Amalfi, with a photo stop in Positano along the way. There will be a stop for lunch (not included) on the way to Amalfi. At the end of the day, you will travel to Sorrento, where you will stay overnight at your hotel. Lunch and dinner are not included.

### September 27 – Sorrento, Capri & Naples

Have breakfast at your hotel before checking out. Depart on your private mini-bus to the port. Once you arrive, meet your guide, catch the hydrofoil, and head to the island of Capri. During this trip, you'll have the opportunity to discover Capri and Anacapri. After lunch, return to the port, where you will catch the hydrofoil to Naples. Lunch and dinner are not included.

*OPTIONAL: If time and weather permit, you can take a boat tour of the famous Blue Grotto (approximate current rate is \$60 per person).*

### September 28 – Naples, Palermo & Cefalù

Check out of your hotel after breakfast. Head to the airport in Naples to depart for Palermo. Once you arrive in Palermo, meet your driver and travel to Cefalù. There, you will renew your vows at the Cathedral of Cefalù. This celebration will be organized by your tour host. The rest of the day will be at your leisure. Stay overnight in Cefalù. Lunch and dinner are not included.

### September 29 – Cefalù

Breakfast will be at your hotel, followed by a free day to relax, shop, or do other activities of your choice. Stay overnight in Cefalù. Lunch and dinner are not included.

### September 30 – Cefalù, Enna & Calascibetta

Check out of the hotel after breakfast. Depart from Cefalù and head to Calascibetta, which is two hours away. After an enjoyable visit at Calascibetta, check into your hotel in Enna. Spend the rest of your day at leisure. Lunch and dinner are not included.

### October 1 – Mount Etna, Riposto & Taormina

After breakfast, visit Mount Etna. Afterward, continue to Riposto. In the afternoon, drive to Taormina. At the end of the day, check into your hotel in Taormina/Acireale. Lunch and dinner are not included.

### October 2 – Taormina, Catania, Rome, New York

After breakfast and checkout, depart for the airport in Catania. You'll catch your flight to Rome, then fly from Rome to New York City.



Guests taking an extension may be on a different flight than their group and/or traveling companion.

Similarly without limiting the foregoing, passenger agrees to hold NTS harmless for any defect in any vehicle, plane, boat, bus, car, van or other vehicle, act of war or insurrection, terrorist activity, revolt or other civil uprising, military action, strikes or labor unrest or any Act of God or for any other act of any third party. Florida law will be applicable to any dispute which arises out of or concerns this brochure or your tour. Any and all litigation must be brought only in and for courts in Polk County, Florida to the exclusion of litigation anywhere else in the world.

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
