ITINERARY

November 25 - Depart the USA

Embark on the trip of a lifetime today with Pastors Matt & Kati Heck

November 26 - Arrive Tel Aviv / Dinner & Overnight

You'll be greeted by our friendly NTS representative upon completion of passport control in Tel Aviv. Transfer to your Tiberias hotel for dinner and a good night's rest!

November 27 - Galilee / Mount of Beatitudes / Magdala / Capernaum / Boat Ride / Fish Lunch / Beit Shean

Explore the wonders of the Sea of Galilee today. Visit the peaceful Mount of Beatitudes that overlooks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7). Walk the recent excavations of the town of Magdala, connected with Mary Magdalene. Travel to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry in Galilee. Stand in the ruins of the synagogue built on the remains of the one where Jesus taught (Matt 4). See the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter professed his devotion three times to the risen Christ (John 21). Enjoy a beautiful boat ride across the Sea of Galilee, followed by a St. Peter's fish lunch. Explore the massive excavations at Beit Shean, a city continuously inhabited for over 5,000 years, including when the Philistines hung the bodies of King Saul and his sons from its walls (1 Sam 31). Later known as Scythopolis, the ruins of this once-opulent Roman city still impress visitors with its city streets, marble sidewalks, Roman public baths, and theater. Return back to your hotel for a delicious buffet dinner and overnight.

November 28 - Chorazim / Caesarea Philippi / Tel Dan / Golan Heights / Mount Ben Tel / Kursi / Jordan River Baptism Site

Start your day today by walking the streets of Chorazim, listed as a "city of woe" by Jesus in Matthew 11. Continue north to Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where nearby Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ" in Matthew 16. Continue to one of the ancient boundary markers of Israel, Tel Dan, and view Abraham's Gate and the alter King Jeroboam built in the north. (1 King 12). Continue on to the Golan Heights and the top of Mount Ben Tel. Gain a greater understanding of the strategic importance of this region to the security of Israel. Continue on to Kursi, where the demoniac was delivered from his torture when he met the Savior. He then became an evangelist, telling his friends in the cities of the decapolis what great things God had done for him and how He had mercy on Him. Remember your baptism at the Yardenit Baptismal site, where the Jordan River exits the Sea of Galilee on its journey southward (Matthew 3). Return to your Tiberias hotel for dinner and overnight

November 29 - Mount Kabir / Mount Gerizim / Tabernacle Model at Ariel / Bethel

Today, we say goodbye to Galilee and journey south into the region of ancient Samaria. View Mount Kabir, the Gate to the Promise Land. Visit Mount Gerizim, the mount of blessing where Israel was told about God's provision that would come from their obedience when Israel first entered the promised land. Shiloh is also in this area, home of the Tabernacle and Ark of the Covenant, for hundreds of years during the days of the Judges. Bethel lies north of Jerusalem and is the site of Jacob's dream with angels ascending and descending from heaven on a ladder. Continue south through the Jordan Valley and then turn west in the Judean Wilderness to the capital city of Jerusalem. Check in to your hotel in Jerusalem

November 30 - Mount Zion / House of Caiaphas / Upper Room / King David's Tomb / Western Wall / Rabbi's Tunnels / Teaching Steps / City of David / Pool of Bethesda

Visit Mount Zion, where you'll have the opportunity to stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14). View the traditional location of King David's Tomb. Cross the street to the House of Caiaphas, where some say Jesus was questioned on the night of His betrayal. Enjoy the opportunity to say a prayer at the Western Wall and explore the Rabbi's Tunnels under the old city. View the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle (John 5:1-31). Sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne and experience its rich acoustics. Visit the Davidson Center, where the Southern Wall Excavations of the ancient temple, including the Teaching Steps. Walk through the City of David excavations, taking you back 3,000 years in time. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

December 1 - Ein Gedi / Jericho / Dead Sea

Visit Ein Gedi, where David sought refuge from Saul. Take an opportunity to swim in the mineral-laden waters of the Dead Sea, whose buoyancy and medicinal benefits are world-renowned. Head to Jericho to visit the ruins of the ancient city Joshua conquered (Joshua 6:20). From Jericho, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matthew 4:1). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.



December 2 - Mount of Olives / Palm Sunday Road / Garden of Gethsemane / Bethlehem / Church of Nativity / Shepherds' Field / Garden Tomb

Stand on the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives. Walk down the Palm Sunday Road and take some time to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane, as Jesus did after the Last Supper and before He was arrested (Matt. 26). In Bethlehem, visit the cave revered as Jesus' birthplace and see the Church of the Nativity constructed over the site (Matt. 1:18-25). Gaze out over Shepherds' Field before returning to Jerusalem. Visit Gordon's Calvary and the Garden Tomb. You will have the opportunity for communion together as you celebrate the glory of the Lord's Resurrection. Check into your hotel in Netanya.

December 3 - Caesarea Maritima / Tel Megiddo / Nazareth / Mount Precipice / Cana

After our delicious buffet breakfast, we will travel to Caesarea by the Sea on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the Centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 & 26). View the heights of Mount Carmel, where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Visit Tel Megiddo, where twenty different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Visit Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus (Luke 2), from the top of Mount Precipice. It was here that an angry crowd from the synagogue attempted to throw Jesus off a cliff (Luke 4). Pass through Cana, the site of the first recorded Miracle of Jesus (John 2). Prepare for your journey home with the life-long memories created during your tour.

December 4 - RETURN

Return to the USA today with memories to last a lifetime!

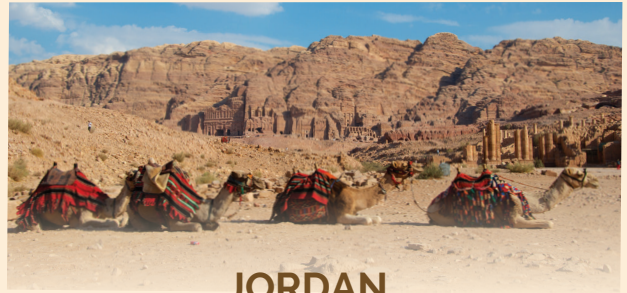

December 4 – Allenby Bridge, Jabbok, Mount Nebo, Petra

Cross the Allenby Bridge into the country of Jordan and drive to Pisgah (the top of Mount Nebo) to view the land of Israel as Moses did before he died. On a clear day, you can see all the way across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea to the rooftops of Jerusalem and Bethlehem. Continuing south your driver will take you close to the Jabbok River where Jacob wrestled the angel of the Lord. Continue south on the King's Highway to Petra for check-in, dinner, and overnight.

December 5 – Petra, Dead Sea

Today, you can explore the remains of the city of Petra, designated as one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. Petra's entrance passes through a long, narrow gorge known as the Siq and can only be accessed by carriage, horseback, or on foot. Once inside the city, marvel at the intricate detail of a city that was cut into the cliffsides of rose-colored rock. Travel to your hotel at the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

December 6 – Return to Tel Aviv

Today, you will cross the border back into Israel and enjoy a falafel lunch. Before boarding your flight home, you will enjoy dinner at the Olive Tree Hotel and then transfer to the Tel Aviv airport.

December 7 – Return to the USA

Guests taking an extension may be on a different flight than their group and/or traveling companion.
