ITINERARY

Day 1 – DEPART FROM THE USA

Day 2 – ARRIVE IN DUBAI

Arrive at Dubai International Airport, where you will be welcomed by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Check into your hotel and rest.

Day 3 - OLD DUBAI

After breakfast, travel to the Al Fahidi Historical Neighborhood to explore Old Dubai. Part of the attraction of the district, which highlights the traditional way of life in Dubai from the mid-19th century until the 1970s, is simply wandering through its narrow lanes. Here, you will discover creative art spaces, museums, and cafés housed in traditional L-shaped homes made from gypsum, coral, and limestone. While exploring this neighborhood, you will visit the Textile Souk, full of colorful fabrics and kitsch souvenirs. Next, you will visit the Saruq Al Hadid Archaeological Museum to discover the archaeological treasures in and around Dubai. Embark on a water taxi ride by Dubai Creek at Bur Dubai Abra Station. This waterway reflects Dubai's historical roots when early settlers relied on its waters for their livelihood. You will queue for a short trip across the creek to Deira on traditional wooden boats known as abras. Once on the other side, visit the Gold Souk, where you can haggle with shopkeepers for beautiful jewelry before continuing to the Spice Souk. As you wander through the stalls, you can savor the aromas of cardamom turmeric, dried lemons, and rose petals. (B)

Day 4 – ABU DHABI & DINNER CRUISE

Embark on this exhilarating tour to Abu Dhabi. Listen to the region's rich history and culture as you travel to your first destination along the Gulf Coast of Abu Dhabi. Visit the architectural beauty of the country's largest mosque, the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, known as the acclaimed symbol of contemporary Islam. The place offers a feast for the eyes as it blends the cultural diversity of Islamic art and contemporary design. Now, you will travel to your next destination, Abu Dhabi Corniche. Feel relaxed seeing the sweeping curve of the clean water harbor, pearl white sand beaches, and the beautiful promenade that stretches along the Northwest city shore. Your next visit is to the Emirates Palace. Get a chance to pose in front of this eminent destination and take many photos. Later, travel to the next photo stop destination, the stunning five towers of Abu Dhabi, Etihad Towers. Having a combination of luxury and modern views, this place is an ideal destination during your Abu Dhabi visit. Enjoy time for lunch at a local restaurant before traveling to Qasr Al Watan. Absorb the essence of culture, architectural features, and the palace's awe-inspiring Emirates history. Learn about the amazing journey of the spurring Arabian design to the present state. Learn about Emirati governance and culture through the palace exhibits. Return to Dubai and freshen up at your hotel before starting your dinner cruise aboard the Bateaux Dubai. As you sail around Dubai, you will pass the illuminated Maktoum Bridge, Clock Tower, Twin Towers, and Grand Mosque. (B, D)

Day 5 - NEW DUBAI & DESERT TRIP

You begin your tour today by driving to the famous man-made island, Palm Jumeirah. Cross the 800-meter-long underwater tunnel and reach the 12-kilometer-long water-breaker with the luxury resort Atlantis, The Palm. Make a photo stop at the magnificent Atlantis Hotel. Then, you will continue to the Dubai Marina, an exclusive residence, leisure, and trade area. You will enjoy a short stroll along the water and admire the new skyline with over 260 skyscrapers from Marina's yacht harbor. Wander through Souk Madinat Jumeirah, Dubai's "Little Venice," with its highly elaborate construction as a lagoon city in the style of old Arabian palaces with typical wind towers. Stroll over the colorful and lively Souk Madinat, a picture sque setting in Arabian style. From here, you can enjoy a fantastic view of the 7-star luxury hotel Burj Al Arab. The magnificent finale to your "New" Dubai tour is visiting the Burj Khalifa. At 828 meters, it is currently the tallest building in the world. It is next to the Dubai Mall, one of the world's largest shopping centers, with 1,200 shops. Visit the viewing platform at 452 meters above sea level. Ride the building's express elevator to the 124th floor at a speed of ten meters per second. From there, you can enjoy a breathtaking 360-degree view of Dubai and its unique skyline. *you will zoom into the remote Lahbab desert outside the city this afternoon. During the drive, your guide will tell you all about the region. Head off-road into bright red dunes and have your camera ready to capture incredible vistas. During a break to gather the convoy, use optional quad bikes on-site to explore more. Then, hold on tight as you cruise toward the highest slopes. Feel the adrenaline race as your vehicle plows up the dunes before sliding and slipping back down the slopes, churning up billowing clouds of sand. Reach a high desert dune for a photo stop and admire the 360-degree views of the desert landscape as the sun slowly sets. Take a camel ride, surf the dunes on a sandboard, and enjoy a BBQ dinner before you return to your hotel. (B, D)

*Guests who do not want to visit the desert can be dropped off at the Dubai Mall for shopping and can stay to see the fountain show before returning to the hotel on their own.

Day 6 – FREE DAY

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel. Your day is free for shopping or exploring on your own. (B)

Transfer to the airport for final departure.
